The Helen McElfresh Scholarship is provided to a senior at Knox County High School to help further the student's education to contribute to the well-being of future Missourians. Mrs. McElfresh taught elementary students at Novelty and hundreds of social studies students at KCHS. Her husband, John, served as Circuit Clerk and Recorder of Deeds of Knox County for 28 years. Daughter, Nancy, is retired as a business teacher at Moberly and daughter, Lynne, is retired as a social worker in Union. Mrs. McElfresh served as a mentor and supporter of Knox County youth for many years and her family gives this scholarship to help today's youth serve future generations.

The Helen McElfresh Scholarship will be given to a graduating senior from Knox County R-1 High School in the amount of \$1,000.

To qualify for this award the student must:

1. Intend to further his/her education at a four year college or university, community college, or technical school.
2. Intend to pursue a career in the human or health services field (examples: education, nursing, health care, social work, etc.)
3. Submit a typed application form to the school counselor's office by **March 15**.
