

Knox County Young Farmer Scholarship

The Knox County Young Farmers will offer an annual scholarship of **\$200** to a graduating senior from Knox County R-I High School for the purpose of continuing his/her education. The award will not be renewable during the subsequent years of post-secondary education or training.

The recipient of this scholarship is free to select any accredited post-secondary institution of learning. The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient after proof of maintaining a 2.5 GPA for the first semester of study.

In the event the scholarship winner does not enroll in a post-secondary institution of learning as planned, does not stay through one semester of study, or does not maintain a 2.5 GPA, the scholarship gift will not be issued.

Applicants should apply by filling out, or electronically duplicating the attached application. A **typed application** should be returned to the counselor's office by **March 15**. Selection of the recipient will be made by a local committee consisting of active members of the Knox County Young Farmers Organization.

Preference will be given to applicants that meet the following:

1. Have an agricultural background
2. Enrolled in high school agricultural class
3. An active member of the FFA
4. Indicate an interest in pursuing a major in an agricultural field
5. Show a financial need
6. Participate in school and community activities
7. Have a reputation for good citizenship and good moral character
