

American Red Cross Services High School Young Minds Change Lives Scholarship Application

Any high school that currently has a scheduled American Red Cross Blood Drive during the 2015-2016 academic year is eligible to participate in the scholarship program. The scholarship amount awarded by the Red Cross to any graduating senior(s) from a high school participating in the Young Minds Change Lives Scholarship Program is determined by totaling the number of units collected at the school blood drive(s) held during the program timeframe. Below is the chart reflecting the scholarship amount that will be awarded based on range of units collected.

Total Blood Donations	Scholarship Amount
35-70	\$250
71-100	\$500
101-150	\$750
151-200	\$1000

Applicants need to be graduating seniors but do not need to have donated blood or been involved in the organization sponsoring the blood drive; however, preference may be given to those students involved in the blood drive or the host organization. Applications must be submitted to your High School Counselor.
